American Endowment Foundation Reports Charitable Contributions, Grants Rise in 2010 Contributing Appreciated Assets Offers New Opportunities

"Although much of America's wealth is comprised of appreciated assets, both liquid and less-liquid, few Americans consider donating such assets," explained Tobin. "Giving appreciated assets to an entity like AEF, gives the donor tremendous flexibility in supporting his or her favorite charitable interests, while enjoying the best tax benefits available," said Tobin.
