



## 10 Highly Rated Charities Relying on Private Contributions

Most charities derive large chunks of revenue from earned income, membership fees, and government contracts and grants.

**Ranked by overall score, these 10 excellent charities draw revenue solely from direct and indirect public support.** They report no government funding, no membership fees, and no revenue from earned income. As a result, **more than 95% of their total revenue comes from private contributions**, which makes the efficiency of their fundraising operations all the more impressive.
